Unfortunately we are unable to provide the information you have requested as this information is not centrally held and would require a review of manual records. The cost of locating and retrieving the information exceeds the “appropriate limit” as stated in the

Freedom of Information (Fees and Appropriate Limit) Regulations 2004. It has been estimated that it would take more than 18 hours to locate and retrieve the requested information. To obtain this information would exceed the £450 limit and is therefore cost prohibitive.

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
