RAMI	Risk Adjusted Mortality Index	Is a ratio of an observed number of deaths to an expected number of deaths in a particular population. The index is simply the number of observed events divided by the number of expected events
SHMI	Summary Hospital-level Mortality Indicator	The Summary Hospital-level Mortality Indicator (SHMI) compares the actual number of patients who die following hospitalisation at a Trust, with the number that would be expected to die on the basis of average Northern Ireland figures, given the characteristics of the patients treated there. SHMI analysis is provided to all HSCTs by the Department of Health Information Analysis Directorate

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
