

Our Hearing Aid User Support Service enables people to make the most of their hearing aids and manage their hearing loss effectively. We deliver drop-in support sessions across Northern Ireland in partnership with local Health and Social Care Trusts and can also arrange home visits.

We also support older people in residential homes and train Social Care Staff in Care Homes.

We provide:

- Information on how to look after and fit hearing aids
- Re-tubing, earmould cleaning and battery replacement (NHS hearing aids only)
- Hearing checks
- Information about coping with hearing loss, equipment and communication tips
- Talks on managing hearing loss and hearing health training
- Information about other services that can provide support
