The Job Coach's role is to carry out a vocational profile which assists in matching the trainee's skills and interests with the right job and/or training option.

- Offers continuous support to the participant, their family and the employer
- To encompass the principle of empowerment for each person
- To develop new work opportunities and identify training needs for each participant
