What the Transition Team does



Transition is when people move from Children's Services to Adult Services.



People move from Children's to Adult Services on their 18th birthday.



The Transition Team helps people move from Children's to Adult Services.

People on the Transition Team



You will have a Transition Team Case Manager.



The Transition Team has Occupational Therapists.



The Transition Team has a Physiotherapist.



The Transition Team has Speech and Language Therapists.

How the Transition Team can help you



Your Case Manager will talk to you to find out what is important to you.



Your Case Manager will help you decide what you want to do when you leave school.



Your Case Manager will talk to staff in the Transition Team about what support you will need in Adult Services.



Your Case Manager will talk to other people to help decide what support you will need.

How the Transition Team can help you



Your Case Manager will make a plan for transition with you and your parents/carers.



You will transfer to Community Adult Services when you have left school with the support you need.
