# GET SET TO ACCESS ALL AREAS

We are committed to working closely with statutory partners and local groups to provide quality opportunities for people with disabilities across the borough, to lead active and healthy lives.

Our partners, Disability Sport NI offer a range of programmes:

### ALL OUT TREKKING GOSFORD FOREST PARK

An inclusive outdoor experience for people to access the walking and mountain bike trails at Gosford Forest Park using four wheeled, battery powered buggies. Seasonal, booking required.

### GOGA FIT

Low intensity, inclusive fitness class, with seated and standing options, body weight, light resistance and cardio exercises. Available at various facilities.

### NORDIC WALKING SOUTH LAKE LEISURE CENTRE

Using 90% of the muscles in the body to improve cardio fitness, develop strength, improve posture and reduce the impact on joints.

### AUTISM AND SPORTS PROGRAMME

Inclusive opportunity for children with Autism aged 7-12 years to develop their fundamental sports skills in an environment that suits their needs. Friends and Siblings are also welcome. Facilities vary from programme to programme.

### INCLUSIVE CYCLING SOUTH LAKE LEISURE CENTRE

Cycling sessions for families, small groups and individuals using a range of inclusive bikes. Includes an outdoor summer programme and indoor winter programme.

### SOUTH LAKE DISABILITY SPORTS CLUB

Multi sports and leisure club for disabled adults aged 19+.

### INCLUSIVE GYM FOR ADULTS AND TEENS

Initial induction as well as 1:1 support for up to 4 weeks, with the aim of helping clients to develop their confidence in order to continue to access the gym independently. Available at various Centres.

### TAI CHI FOR HEALTH

Gentle exercises to improve strength, balance and coordination.

### CRAIGAVON BOCCIA CLUB SOUTH LAKE LEISURE CENTRE

# GET ACTIVE WITH OUR ACTIVITIES

## ACCESSIBLE GLAMPING GOSFORD FOREST PARK

Pods include a level access, widened door and large internal turning space, sleeping a maximum of four people. Access to the accessible toilet and shower room in the centre of the campsite.

## AUTISM & ADDITIONAL NEEDS SPLASH SESSIONS ORCHARD LEISURE CENTRE

One hour calm and quiet sessions with limited numbers in the pool. Participants may be accompanied by ONE parent, guardian or helper in the pool.

## AUTISM FRIENDLY SOFT PLAY ORCHARD LEISURE CENTRE

Gulliver's Soft Play is for tots, toddlers and children of primary school age. The Autism Friendly sessions are a calm safe space for children with Autism to have fun & relax.

## DISABILITY SWIMMING ORCHARD LEISURE CENTRE

Participants with a disability will have the opportunity to swim for FREE at their own pace within a lane allocated solely for them. A carer will be permitted FREE entry into the same lane, if the person with the disability needs assistance.

## INCLUSIVE CYCLE SCHEME SOUTH LAKE LEISURE CENTRE

A range of bikes, including trikes, hand cycles, tandems and a wheelchair transporter are available to hire by individuals, families and groups.

## INCLUSIVE SNOW SPORTS CRAIGAVON GOLF & SKI CENTRE

Sit skis and a hoist are available to enable people with reduced mobility and wheelchair users to access the slope.

## MOVE MORE ARMAGH BANBRIDGE CRAIGAVON IN PARTNERSHIP WITH MACMILLAN

Is a physical activity project that supports people living with and beyond cancer to become and remain active. Available across all Centres.

## WHEELY BOAT SOUTH LAKE LEISURE CENTRE

A wheelchair accessible boat, comfortably fitting a maximum of 2 wheelchairs and up to 4 adults.
