# Activity Support provides interaction and support to patients/service users to help them engage in activities to enhance their experience





**Current Status** This role has returned in many Day Centres and Children's Wards in both CAH & DHH



- Suitable for Children's Wards, Stroke and Rehab wards, Day Centre's, Supported Living, Day Opportunities, etc
- Providing opportunities for the future workforce and/or those wishing to give back. Currently lots of interest with existing volunteers keen to return and many students

## Fit 4 U Activity Support supporting service users with physical activities in local leisure centres



**Current Status** This role is fully returned



- Assist and support adults with physical/sensory disabilities at local leisure facilities to participate in physical activity co-ordinated through Fit 4 U Project. E.g. Boxercise, boccia, bowls, kurling, fitness suite, dance, archery, walking etc.
- This role developed to assist in guided walks outdoors during the pandemic.

### Here to Help directing and assisting visitors find their way around the hospitals

#### Current Status

This role has returned to CAH & DHH. We have many returning and new volunteers Excellent feedback from staff, patients and visitors, including a thank you from Health Minister Robin Swann during a visit.



Role is suitable for those wishing to give back and students during the school holidays. Role takes place Monday to Friday 9-4

#### **Meet & Greet in A&E** assist patients to navigate around A&E and support those needing additional help in the A&E environment



- Current Status This role is currently stood down
- To assist patients coming into A&E to enhance patients experience, direct them to various areas, help those who may not have heard their name being called and chat to those anxious as they wait
- Demand among current volunteers keen to return as they volunteer outside of their work hours and our future workforce

### **Volunteer Drivers** assist the transport department in escorting service users to and from day time facilities

#### Breast Feeding Peer Support supporting mothers to

succeed at breastfeeding





#### **Current Status**

This role has been able to continue throughout the pandemic as it can be provided virtually

- This role is suitable for those who have successfully breastfed. There is a waiting list for training.
- Referrals are made by the Breast Feeding link workers

### **Pets as Therapy** bringing pets to Trust settings to encourage service users to interact and gain therapeutic benefits

Current Status Role returned



- Suitable for Day Centres, Supported Living, Day Opportunities, etc.
- More Pets as Therapy volunteers are required

#### Meal Time Support Volunteers help

patients/service users enjoy their meal and receive good nutrition by providing encouragement, assistance to cut up food, remove lids and assist with eating and drinking if needed.





#### **Current Status**

This role is currently stood down, but Volunteer Coordinators are part of the Meal Time Matters Implementation Group

- This role is suitable for all wards, acute and non acute, and day facilities that provide meals, to enhance the meal times experience
- There is a great interest for this role among our workforce of the future

**Befriending** supporting and engaging with patients/service users during their time in hospital, day facilities or during planned activities

Current Status This role is currently stood down









- This role is suitable for all wards, acute and non acute, Day Centre's, Supported Living, Day Opportunities, etc
- Interest among retired volunteers keen to give back and provide some company to service users

### **Mentor** supporting young people and providing diversionary activities





Current Status This role is yet to be reinstated

Suitable for CYP services with young people who would benefit from one to one encouragement and support



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
