**2) How many times has a vulnerable adult been subjected to an incident of abuse in each year 2018 - 2013?**

In order to provide this information a significant manual trawl of records from a number of sources is required. Therefore this request cannot be processed. This is because the cost of locating and retrieving the information exceeds the “appropriate limit” as stated in the Freedom of Information (Fees and Appropriate Limit) Regulations 2004. In order to obtain this information from a number of departments it would exceed the £450 limit and is therefore cost prohibitive.

**3) How many allegations / incidents of physical or verbal abuse (or other forms) to an employee/staff member in each year 2018-2023**

The SHSCT use CCS coding to theme incidents reported on the Datix Risk Management System. In April 2019, all Northern Ireland Trusts moved from CCS1 coding to CCS2 coding.

The number of incidents broken down by CCS1 code is provided below for 2018/19.

The Trust has a legal duty to protect patient confidentiality and, in line with this duty, the figure <5 has been provided where figures are very low. This is because of the potential risk of identification of an individual. In reaching this decision the Trust has taken into account the small geographical area which the Trust serves and the sensitivity of the information requested. In addition the Trust has taken into account the fact that all information disclosed in response to an FOI is disclosed to the 'world at large' and is published on the Trust website.

S 40 (2) (third party information) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 has been applied to exempt the redacted information from disclosure. The Trust does not consider the disclosure of the redacted information to be fair to the individuals concerned as there is the potential risk of identification of an individual(s) which they would not expect, and which would therefore breach the fairness element of the first principle of the Data Protection Act 2018.

#### **4) How many times has a staff member been subjected to an incident of abuse in each year 2018-2023.**

The table below displays the number of different 'contact' IDs assigned to each Incident. A 'contact' is a record on the Datix Risk Management system, which includes staff members. On review of these incidents, on occasion, there are duplicate contacts within the incident. To remove these duplicates would be a manual exercise and would exceed the 18 hour exemption limit.
