Who are Access & Information?

The team consists of Access & Information Officers and a Team Manager providing dedicated professional support to Older People & Primary Care.

All referrals to OPPC, Integrated Care Team -Social Work, OT and District Nursing – (District Nursing - Armagh & Dungannon Pilot commenced in January 2017), Reablement, Intermediate Care Scheme and Adult Continence are channelled through Access & Information.

Exceptions are Memory Team where existing process for referrals still apply.

Access & Information also process Out of Hours referrals from the Regional Emergency Social Work Service (R.E.S.W.S.) for OPPC Trust wide.

Who Access & Information refer to:

- Integrated Care Teams (ICT) OPPC across the Southern Trust (SHSCT).
- Reablement Teams across the Southern Trust (SHSCT).
- Intermediate Care Scheme (ICS) across the Southern Trust.
- District Nursing (pilot Armagh & Dungannon).
- Community Occupational Therapy (ICT) OPPC Trust wide.
- Care Home Support across the Southern Trust.
- Adult Continence Service across the Southern Trust.
- Community and Volunteering Organisations
