FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 – INFORMATION REQUEST

A) Copy of all emails and letters sent to RQIA between 2020 and 2024 relating to concerns at Aughnacloy House Nursing Home.

Response:

In order to provide this information a significant manual trawl of records from a number of sources is required. The cost of locating and retrieving the information exceeds the “appropriate limit” as stated in the Freedom of Information (Fees and Appropriate Limit) Regulations 2004. In order to obtain this information, it would exceed the £450 limit and is therefore cost prohibitive.

Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, Public Authorities are not obliged to comply with an information request where to do so would exceed the cost limit.

B) How many allegations of abuse of a vulnerable adult at Aughnacloy House between 2020 and 2024?

Response:

Between 1st January 2020 and 7th March 2024 there were 27 referrals to adult protection where the adult was resident in Aughnacloy House.

C) How many allegations above were substantiated?

Response:
