- **Number of requests approved on initial application**
- **Number of requests approved after appeal**
- **Number of requests approved after grievance or other escalation**

Response:

This information is not recorded centrally and therefore retrieving it would involve a manual search of individual staff records. As such we cannot provide this information as the cost of locating and retrieving the information exceeds the “appropriate limit” as stated in the Freedom of Information (Fees and Appropriate Limit) Regulations 2004. In order to obtain this information from a number of staff records would exceed the £450 limit and is therefore cost prohibitive.

Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, Public Authorities are not obliged to comply with an information request where to do so would exceed the cost limit.
