## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 – INFORMATION REQUEST

### Question:

**Under Freedom of Information, please provide the number of claims made against the Trust in terms of human rights breaches, and of these how many resulted in compensation/damages being paid shown by whether liability was accepted or not, in each of the last three financial years ending March 2024.**

### Response:

Please be advised that claims made against the Trust are not categorised in relation to 'Human Rights' breaches. Therefore retrieving this information would involve a manual search of every employment claim over the last 3 years. As such we cannot provide this information as the cost of locating and retrieving the information exceeds the "appropriate limit" as stated in the Freedom of Information (Fees and Appropriate Limit) Regulations 2004. In order to obtain this information and it would exceed the £450 limit and is therefore cost prohibitive.

Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, Public Authorities are not obliged to comply with an information request where to do so would exceed the cost limit.
