Question: Can I have the number of patients - presented monthly far past year, who reside in these postcodes BT70 BT74 BT75 BT76 BT78 BT79 BT81 BT92 BT93 BT94 Can I please have the numbers who attended as a result of a road traffic collision, Altnagelvin South West Acute Hospital Craigavon Royal Victoria Hospital as a result of a road traffic collision, either by ambulance, HEMS or their own transport.

Please can I have data monthly by each of the following routes: either by ambulance, HEMS, PSNI or by their own transport.

Response:

The information you have requested is not centrally recorded and a manual search of records would be required to be undertaken to complete the request.

Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, Public Authorities are not obliged to comply with an information request where to do so would exceed the cost limit.

Unfortunately we are unable to provide the information you have requested as the cost of locating and retrieving the information exceeds the “appropriate limit” as stated in the Freedom of Information (Fees and Appropriate Limit) Regulations 2004. It has been estimated that it would take more than 18 hours to locate and retrieve the requested information. In order to obtain this information and it would exceed the £450 limit and is therefore cost prohibitive.
