FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 – INFORMATION REQUEST

QUESTION

In 2023, of all the patients receiving enoxaparin, how many of them followed the posology of receiving injections once a day? And how many received injections twice a day?

RESPONSE

The information you have requested is not centrally recorded and to collate this information would require a manual review of each service user record.

Unfortunately, therefore we are unable to provide the information you have requested as the cost of locating and retrieving the information exceeds the “appropriate limit” as stated in the Freedom of Information (Fees and Appropriate Limit) Regulations 2004. It has been estimated that it would take more than 18 hours to locate and retrieve the requested information. In order to obtain this information and it would exceed the £450 limit and is therefore cost prohibitive.

In addition, the Trust do not consider it appropriate or in keeping with data protection legislation to review individual patient records for the purposes of responding to a Freedom of Information Request as the individual would not have this reasonable expectation. This would therefore breach the first data protection principle which requires that personal information is processed fairly and lawfully.

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
