Data has been extracted using Primary Diagnosis or Sec Diag Code 1 - 15 - Polycythaemia Vera D45.X, Myelofibrosis D47.4, Essential Thrombocytopenia D47.3 & Myeloproliferative Disease D47.1 (codes supplied by SHSCT Clinical Coding Dept. 12.09.24) 3 most recently coded months

**March 2024 = 99.2% Coded**

**April 2024 = 99.4% Coded**

**May 2024 = 98.0% Coded**

*The Acute Information Team can only provide data based on patients who were admitted to hospital (as an inpatient or daycase). If a patient had a diagnosis at another setting e.g Outpatient, this will not be included in the numbers as Outpatients are not coded with diagnosis codes on the Trusts PAS system (only inpatients and daycases are clinically coded).*

*Also note: the data that is provided is based on patients admitted to hospital and coded with Polycythaemia Vera, Melofibrosis, Essential thrombocytopenia or Myeloproliferative Disease, Chronic as a diagnosis - this does not necessarily mean that the patient was first diagnosed with this condition during this hospital*
