

- Free leaflets, booklets and resources on all aspects of living with and beyond cancer.
- Access to benefits advice & other sources of financial help.
- An opportunity to discuss work related issues such as finding the words to speak to your employer, understanding your rights at work and what reasonable adjustments may enable you to remain in or return to work.
- Access to practical help such as transport and travel insurance.
- Signposting to local services such as counselling, complementary therapies, physical activity programmes & more.
- Access to support programmes to help you deal with the emotional effects of cancer both during and after treatment. E.g. the HOPE Course (Help to Overcome Problems Effectively)
- Signposting to support for your family, children and carers.
- Information about your cancer care and treatment and how you healthcare professionals can help.

The service provides information and support over the phone or by email for those not able to access the service in person.


